Collection of Children

If there is a change to the person collecting your child, please inform us either at drop-off or by telephoning the nursery on 01945 586966. For anyone unfamiliar with collecting your child, we will ask for the password from your child's registration pack.

First Day Absence Calls

Parents/carers must report their child's absence on the first day. Regular attendance is important for your child's learning and development.
Please report absences by calling 01945 586966 or texting 07825 575 225.

Nursery Clothing

As part of our nursery ethos, children have access to messy play activities, which means they will get messy!

Please provide a spare change of clothes to be kept in a bag on your child's peg. All coats, shoes, and clothing should be clearly named.

Please avoid sending children in their best clothes. Nursery sweatshirts and polo shirts can be purchased via:

This helps prevent favourite clothes being marked during play.

Parking

Please Park only in the designated bays in our car park.

Do not park at the front of the building. This is to ensure the safety of all children, families, and staff.

Contact Details

Please keep us updated with your current contact details, especially mobile numbers. It is essential that someone is available to collect your child in the event of an emergency. If you are unavailable, please ensure an alternative contact is provided.

Sickness

Nursery is not suitable for poorly children. If your child has been sick or had an upset stomach, they must remain away from nursery for 48 hours and only return once they have had a normal (for them) stool. Children taking antibiotics should not attend nursery for the first 24 hours. If you are unsure when your child can return, please speak to a member of staff.
